Description: Exploiting the DNA damage response for cancer therapy relies on the fact that rapidly proliferating cancer cells have higher incidences of DNA damage, defective DNA repair pathways, genomic instability, or a combination of these facets. 1-3 Poly(ADP-ribosylation) is a post-translational modification that plays an important role in the repair of damaged sections of DNA.4-6 Poly(ADP-ribose) polymerases (PARPs), in particular PARP1, signal the presence of DNA damage and facilitate DNA repair. ...
